BUDGET 2014

The Board reviewed the 2014 proposed budget. The backhoe payment estimate was increased; income monies from CD were increased to reflect the change in backhoe payment.

- A MOTION by Schield, and seconded by Farischon to adopt with corrections made at the meeting the tentative 2014 General Fund Budget of \$836,955.00. Motion carried.
- A MOTION by Farischon was seconded by Schield to adopt the tentative Liquid Fuels/State Account budget for 2014 in the amount of \$73,194.92. Motion carried.
- Farischon reported that the Police Pension MMO for 2014 will be \$37,129.
- A MOTION by Farischon, and seconded by Schield to purchase a new police car from Milham on Costars contract at the cost of \$36,599.59 or less with leasing to be arranged. Motion carried.
- A MOTION by Schield was seconded by Farischon to purchase two car cameras and two body cameras as per price quote (in care camera \$2599.00 per unit and body cam \$295.00 per unit). Motion carried.

Schield reported a resident claims an alleged stone feel from one of the Township's trucks and cracked their windshield. He recommends paying the \$100 deductible.

- A MOTION by Farischon, and seconded by Schield to adopt Resolution # 3-2013 applying for a grant from Lackawanna County for the purchase of two emergency generators for the Township Building and the Maintenance Building. Motion carried.
- A MOTION by Schield was seconded by Farischon to adjourn at 12:23 PM. Motion carried.
