ENGINEER' S REPORT

Voyack said the design part for the sewer rehab project has taken longer than expected. Generator reps have taken longer than expected to get back to him. He is hoping to put out for bid sometime this month and have the bid opening in a month.

Bid proposals will be in two parts. One contract will be for the generators, metering and clean out the equalization tank. The second contract would be for televising and lining lines.

Flow meters will report by radio to a program on the computer in the office. The meters would be solar with batteries.

The replacement manhole on Blue Shutters Road has been ordered.

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Smoke testing has not been done as yet due to scheduling programs but it is expected to be done soon.
