SOLICITOR

Solicitor Weinschenk reported four letters were sent to lenders regarding delinquent accounts. One bank has been in touch with the solicitor and delinquent fees were paid.

The Atkinson property is scheduled for sheriff's sale on November 18 as well as the Morgan property. Atkinson owes over \$8,000 and Morgan owes approximately \$2,800. The Noon property is for sale and money should be received when sold. Russo owes over \$8,600 in outstanding user fees. The authority decided to send a second letter to Russo and the lender.

Chairman Flynn said he is going to attend a meeting with Spring Brook Sewer Authority to discuss a method to help eliminate or correct the ammonia problem at a lesser cost than other proposals.

Via a phone call, Koberlein reported they tried two attempts at programing the automatic dialers with no success. They suggest we get new ones.
