The regular meeting of the Roaring Brook Township Board of Supervisors was held on Thursday July 2, 2020 at 8:09 pm at the Municipal Building on Blue Shutters Road. Present were Supervisors Anthony Jordan, Robert Farischon and Eric Schield, Police Chief Don Hickey, Solicitor Jenna Kraycer Tuzze, Michelle Wilk, Joe Nayda, and Paul Kozik.

An executive session was held prior to the meeting to discuss legal matters and potential litigation.

Jordan asked for the public to raise their hands rather than shout out comments.
